Please find below the rules and required documentation to complete and submit with this application. Sections A thru K are required to be considered for a scholarship; there will be no exceptions.

a. Three (3) letters of references/recommendation required: - **This is a must**

- One from your Teacher
- One from a minister, deacon, ministry lead
- One from your family members

NOTE: Pls do not request recommendations from Pastor Grice.

b. Official high school transcript in a separate envelope marked **“Transcript-DO NOT OPEN.” This is a must. Failure to comply will disqualify your application.**

c. Students selected for this scholarship **must** have achieved not less than a **“B” or GPA 3.0 average in their high school work for one year.**

d. Proof of college acceptance and address.

e. 250-word essay.

f. Scholarships must be used for study at any accredited higher learning institution.

g. The academic scholarships will not impose restrictions of any kind on the course of study. Recipients may accept any other grants or awards that do not rule out scholarship aid from other sources.

h. Members of True Vine Baptist Church may apply for this academic scholarship. **Applicants must be an active member of True Vine Baptist Church for at least one year immediately preceding the date of the application.** Applicant must be actively involved in a ministry of service, such as ushers, choir, greeters, etc. Sunday School, Wed Night Bible Study, etc., educates and serves the attendee.

i. The applicant must be a senior in high school who have, or will be, graduated at the end of either: 1) the fall semester or 2) the spring semester, in public, private or parochial schools who are planning to attend a college or university anywhere in the United States during the academic year, and who are able to meet the academic requirements for entrance in the university or college of their choice.

j. A recent color photograph, preferably 2 inches by 3 inches, with the applicant's name written on the back of the photograph.

k. **Applications are accepted between March 1, 2017 thru 14 May, 2017.**

3. Students who receive a scholarship must use the funds within one year from the award date of the scholarship. When the student has enrolled in school and shows proof of registration with a Student I.D. number, the checks will be deposited in the student's name and account at the learning institution; half of the award amount will be sent the first semester and half sent the following semester.

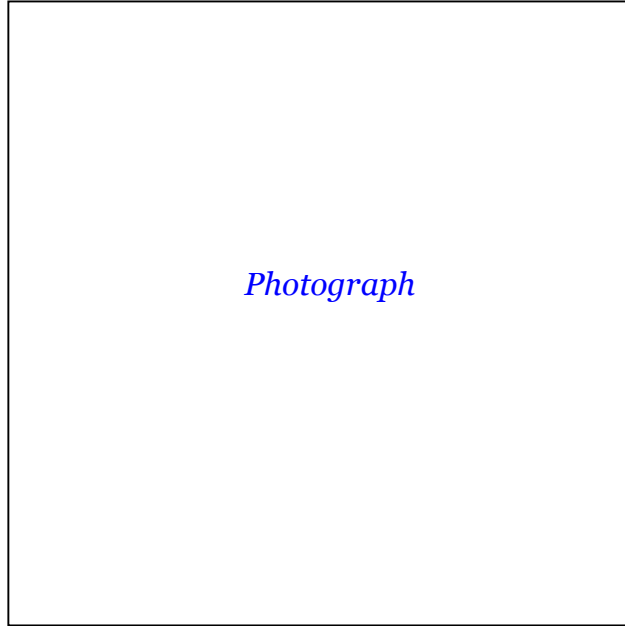
